Update on the Knights' Efforts in Ukraine

Over one year later and Ukrainian families are still suffering from the effects of the ongoing war. Last year, Knights of Columbus responded quickly to support relief efforts in Ukraine through our Ukraine Solidarity Fund. Since then, over 300,000 refugees have been welcomed from Ukraine at eight separate Mercy Centers and over 161,000 Care Packages delivered. 
