A NOTE FROM THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY

We started the new Fiscal Year July 1, 2016, with 250 members. Our target for Star Council is 15 new members, and 6 new insurance members. As of July 22, we lost an insured member.

We received a \$500.00 check from Supreme which is a thank you for participating in the Foods for Families Program, which includes the weekly bread runs, Christ house and the Christmas Basket Program. They recommend we continue to use these additional funds for the food bank or pantry we support now.

NEW LIFE FOR ANGEL BREAD PROJECT

After an almost 2-month hiatus, during which all pick-ups & deliveries of excess bread from the Bimbo distribution center in Springfield to selected food pantries in the Alexandria-Annandale-Springfield area was indefinitely suspended, our Council has received word that higher powers have successfully convinced Bimbo officials of the benefits to all parties involved in this extremely successful charitable program. We expect to meet with Bimbo officials in the near future to work out the details & attend a training session before our team can resume weekly pickups. Although no target date has given, we have notified our various charitable client organizations of the resumption of service to their food pantries and hope to resume operations sometime in August. We thank all who were involved in the discussions to restore help to needy families in our area.
