The Four Cardinal Virtues: Fortitude

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC), on its article on the virtues, quotes this profound thought from Philemon: "Whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things." While most of us know the virtues generally, it is worthwhile to take a deeper dive into them. But, first, a few definitions. The CCC defines virtue as "a habitual and firm disposition to do good." That is something to reflect on, especially as we go through our work as Knights.

The four cardinal virtues are: prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance. Beginning with this month, we shall focus on learning about each cardinal virtue, leaning on our great community of saints (and near saints) to provide us with examples and inspiration. In this month of Bl. Father McGivney's feast, it's appropriate to lift him up as an example of fortitude.

To quote again from the CCC, "Fortitude is the moral virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good." To know a bit of Fr. McGivney's life is to know fortitude. Many of us know the basic details of Fr. McGivney: the eldest of 13 children from a poor Irish Catholic family; a decision to heed the call to the priesthood in spite of his father's opposition; his perseverance through the early death of his father; a dedication throughout his life to the marginalized; a remarkable sense of calm combined with grit; and, of course, the lasting legacy we are all a part of: the Knights of Columbus.

As Knights, we are a persevering bunch. Changes in the wider culture may appear to challenge the counter-cultural principles we believe in unity, charity, fraternity and patriotism. But we keep on pushing forward. Underpinning this grit and courage is our faith in God. Let us lean on Christ, just as Blessed Fr. McGivney did.
