# FRATERNAL ACTIVITIES

## ANGEL BREAD PROJECT TERMINATED?

In response to security and liability concerns, the new Area Manager for Bimbo Bakeries USA has stopped the highly successful charitable program to help needy families in the Springfield-Annandale-Alexandria area. The weekly pickups of bread products for distribution to selected charitable organizations in the Alexandria area for re-distribution to needy families was originally started by Fitzgerald Council 459 some 20 years ago. Our Council became involved with the program in early 2011 in response to a call for help. Although the Angel Bread Project has been a joint venture with the St. Mary knights, we have expanded our participation (the JP2 Team consists of four knights) & the service area to include Annandale & Springfield. Since the beginning of the 2015-16 Columbian Year, our team has collected more than 16.302 loaves of bread or bread products at the Lorton distribution center for selected charitable organizations for re-distribution to needy families. While the program is now ended (the last bread run occurred on June 1), the families that benefitted from it are still in need of help. We sincerely hope that Bimbo officials will reconsider their decision & allow us to resume a program that works and is a win-win for all parties concerned.

# YEAR-END REPORT

The Board of the Casey 4522 Foundation held its final meeting for the 2016 fiscal year on Monday, June 20, in the Council Home. One of the items on the agenda was to elect officers for coming fiscal year. As was expected, the Board reelected all of the current serving officers for another year: Dick Owen, President; Ron Plavchan, Secretary; and Bob Kreider, Treasurer. The Board also approved a \$200 disbursement to Bethany House of Northern Virginia. Total disbursements for FY 2016 amounted to \$14,981 an awarded to 21 501(c)3 organizations.
