2023 Queen of Apostles Men's Retreat

This year's Men's Retreat was held at the "mini Jerusalem" Franciscan Monastery in Washington D.C. We were an intimate group of 12 retreatants mostly Brother Knights but also a number of QofA members - along with the presence of four priests. Worthy Chaplain Fr. Alex Diaz started our day with the Mass in the monastery's Blessed Sacrament Chapel, with a beautiful homily given by Fr. Guillermo Gonzales and concelebrated by visiting priests Fr. Adan and Fr. Saul from El Salvador. For our first talk, Fr. Guillermo brought us reasons to get closer to our Mother Mary, reminding us of her divine connection to Jesus and her own example of humility and obedience. After a period of self-reflection, which some retreatants spent wandering through the beautiful gardens while others spent in prayer and reflection in the main church, some of us gathered together with Fr. Guillermo to share our thoughts in a group.

After a hearty lunch (courtesy of Lady Sonia Oppus), our Worthy Chaplain spoke about praying the rosary – from his own personal experience and its effectiveness as a weapon, to practical tips on how to pray it more frequently. Afterwards, we commenced on a tour of the church itself, which – in addition to a number of beautiful altars – also has replicas of sites from the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. We were also taken for a tour of the "catacombs" under the church. After the tour,

many of us partook of the Sacrament of Reconciliation with one of the Franciscan Friars.

It was a wonderful way to spend a Saturday, and a big thanks to our Brother Knights that came and attended the retreat.

A Note from our Lecturer

The Lenten Mindset: Brothers, as we prepare for the Lenten Season let us take a moment to reflect on our own personal states of grace.

"I do not understand my own behavior; I do not act as I mean to, but I do things that I hate. While I am acting as I do not want to, I still acknowledge the Law as good, so it is not myself acting, but the sin which lives in me. And really, I know of nothing good living in me -- in my natural self, that is -- for though the will to do what is good is in me, the power to do it is not: the good thing I want to do, I never do; the evil thing which I do not want -- that is what I do. But every time I do what I do not want to, then it is not myself acting, but the sin that lives in me.my inmost self I dearly love God's law, but I see that acting on my body there is a different law which battles against the law in my mind. So I am brought to be a prisoner of that law of sin which lives inside my body. What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body doomed to death? God -- thanks be to him -through Jesus Christ our Lord. So it is that I myself with mv mind obev the law of God. but disordered nature I obey the law of sin." - Romans 7:15-

- Prayer (Rosary, Intercessory)
- Alms (Giving money or service)
- Fasting (from Food or other)
- Adoration
- Reading the Bible

May our personal preparation for this Lenten season be as holy as the wonders of the season itself.
