SPOTLIGHT A KNIGHT

The Knight in the Spotlight this month is ... Past Grand Knight Joe Lynem. Take a few minutes to learn about Brother Joe: "I have been a parishioner at Queen of Apostles since 1994. I retired from the Army in 1998 after 22 years of service, and I have worked for the Federal Government since 2002. I became a member of the Knights in 2007 and was quickly installed as the inside guard for Council 4522. The following year I was elected to the position of Deputy Grand Knight and then served as Grand Knight from July 2009 to July 2010. I joined the Knights because as a Catholic man I wanted to be part of this special Catholic organization that serves the Parish and community. Since joining Council 4522 I have been involved in many of the Council programs, you name it I have done it.
