Golden Anniversary Celebrated

Msgr. George E. Dobes, a retired Naval Chaplain & longtime member of our Council, celebrated his 50th



jubilee to the priesthood this year in May (5/2/1968). He joined the Knights of Columbus and the former Fairfax Council on October 2, 1975. Msgr. Dobes is also a 4th Degree member of Commodore John Barry

Assembly No. 1163. What makes Msgr. Dobes so special in our diocese is that he is only one of two priests granted bi-ritual facilities—although ordained as a Roman Catholic priest, he has been granted special permission by Rome and the Bishop of the Eparchy (diocese) of Passaic, NJ to celebrate the Eucharist in

both Latin rite & Byzantine rite liturgies. Msgr. Dobes is now retired and living in South Arlington, however, he continues to assist at both Epiphany of Our Lord Byzantine Church in Annandale and All Saints Church in Manassas. The Council wishes to extend to Msgr. Dobes our sincere thanks for his faithful years of service to our military, Church & Order.
